

Requirements:

- All potential participants must be Junior and Senior members of the American Saddlebred Horse Association.
- Must show a registered American Saddlebred horse that must be current in ownership registration but does not have to be owned by participant.
- Before the opening performance of the National Championship Pleasure Horse Show each year the participant must have accumulated a minimum of 20 points in his/her age group American Saddlebred Pleasure Equitation classes or Championship classes to count. Adult may use UPHA classes if rider uses an American Saddlebred pleasure horse.
- Participant must present Official National Pleasure Equitation Olympic Tabulation Card (see attached) to show official to verify placing in class and number of exhibitors in class – show official must sign Official National Pleasure Equitation Olympic Tabulation Card.
- When required number of points are achieved the Official National Pleasure Equitation Tabulation Card is to be sent to a designated person who will verify results. Upon completion of verification an Official National Equitation Pleasure Olympic Horse Neck Ribbon will be sent to qualifier. Neck ribbon must be worn on horse when qualifier shows at National Pleasure Equitation Olympic Finals to be held at the National Championship Pleasure Horse Show.

Point Tabulation:

- Any age group Pleasure Equitation class to qualify. If a show does not have an American Saddlebred Pleasure Equitation class, points will count from an OPEN Saddle Seat Equitation class and provided the exhibitor is riding a registered American Saddlebred pleasure horse. CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES TO COUNT. (Must walk, trot, and canter.)
- Points awarded by number of class participants. MAXIMUM number of points per class is "8". MINIMUM number of points per class is "1".

Finals Competition:

- To be held at the National Championship Pleasure Horse Show.
- Participants must display neck ribbon on horse during individual entry into ring. Ribbons will then be removed before class begins.
- \$15.00 participant nomination fee at show.
- Class to be judged in accordance with current USA Equestrian Pleasure Equitation rules.
- Judges to be approved by National Championship Pleasure Horse Show Committee.
- Work-out of top 10 riders is required (13 and under, USA tests 1-12; 17 and under, USA tests 1-16). Adults will not be required to drop stirrups. Possible early morning elimination class depending on number of qualifiers.
- Decision of judges is final.

Awards:

Each Division:
 1st – Gold Medal
 2nd – Silver Medal
 3rd – Bronze Medal

The first Top Ten Riders in each class also receive a Tri-Color Top Ten National Pleasure Equitation Olympic Ribbon and Jacket Patch.
